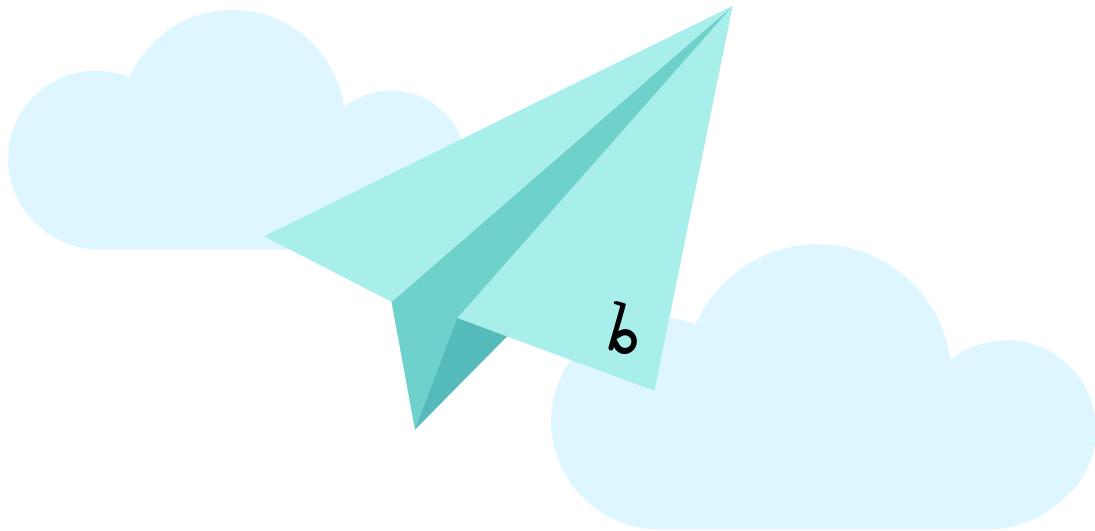


# How to Share your Buncees with your Buncee Buddies



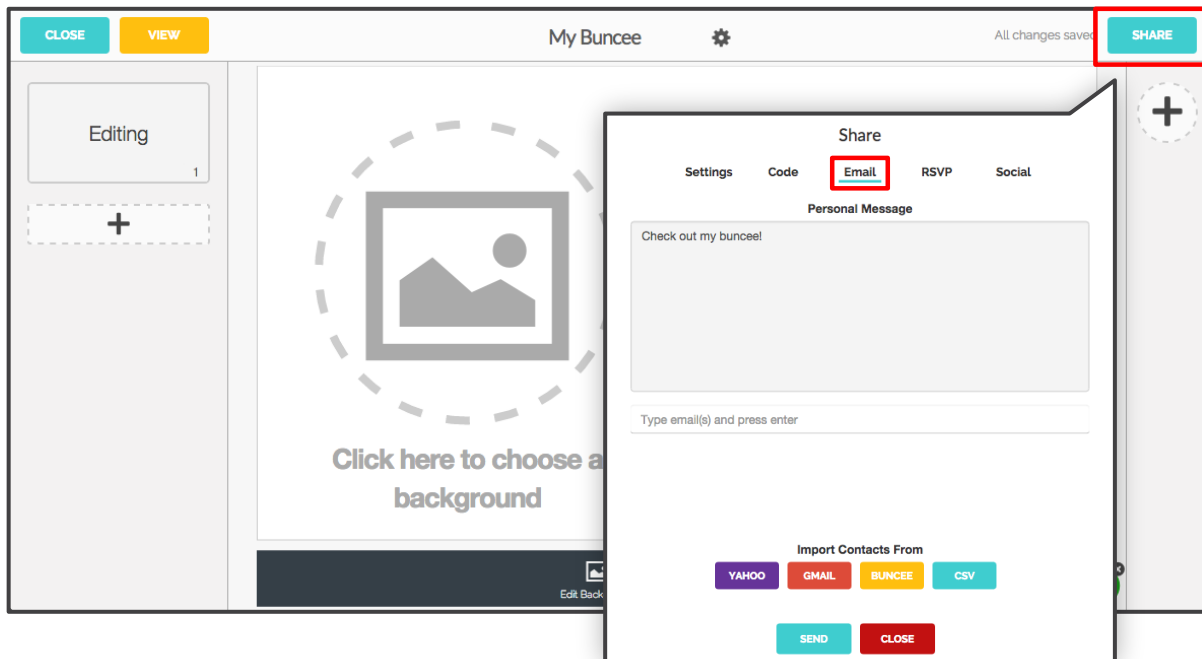
Attached are the steps to sharing your buncees with your buncee buddies. There are two options for sharing your classroom's buncees with your partner class.

# Option 1

Students can email their buncee creation to their partner teacher directly. In doing so, the partner teachers will get an email from each of their partner students with their individual bunces.

1. Once students finish creating their bunces, click the blue colored "Share" button located on the top right corner of their screen. This will open a "Share" window.

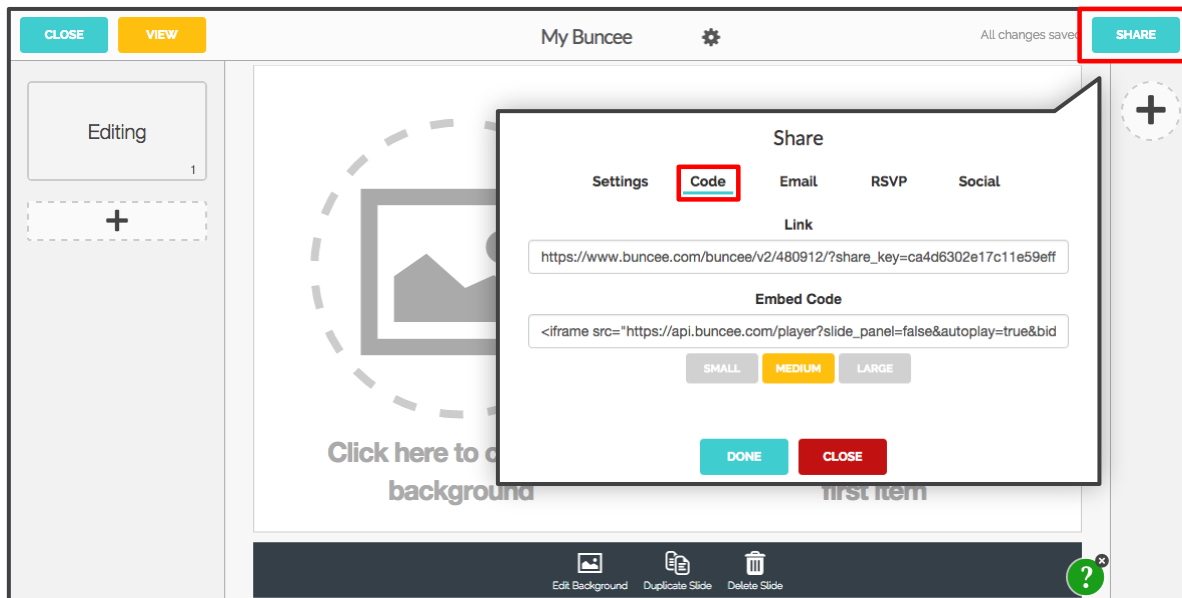


2. In the "Share" window, have students click the "Email" tab. Students can type the partner teacher's email address. In addition, they also have the option to type a personal message to their partner teacher and student.
3. Once complete, each student can click "Send" at the bottom to share their buncee!

# Option 2

Copy the URLs of each students' buncees into a document and share this document with your partner teacher. They can then click on each link to view and share these buncees with their students.

1. Create a Google Doc that every student has access to edit.
2. Once students finish creating their buncees, click the blue colored "Share" button located on the top right corner of their screen. This will open a "Share" window.



3. In the "Share" window, have students click the "Code" tab as shown above. This will show the "Link" and "Embed Code." Have students copy the link provided in the "Code" tab.
4. After copying the code, students can then paste their buncree link into the Google Doc and type their name next to their link, so that their buddies know who made each buncree.
5. Finally, share the Google Doc with your partner teacher.
